

WARNING

- ENSURE you turn the unit off at the very minimum every 15 minutes (for 1 minute) to let the motor cool down - failure to do so may cause motor failure.
- DO NOT use this unit for more than 4 hours (including rest breaks) on any given day.


OPERATION METHOD


Release the lock block to open the up housing, take out wheels and accessories.

1. Install castor wheels into the hole on the base.
2. Install the big wheel into the relevant position and then fix the wheel with screw.
(Please kindly keep the mark on the big wheel ("R" or "L") same as the one ("R" or "L") on wheel base.)



Insert the hose connector into the swivel of the Vacuum Cleaner.




Insert the handle into the tube with a twisting force.






OPERATION METHOD

Hold the plug and insert into socket






You can adjust the airflow by push the sliding block up and down.

If the dust barrel is full, please empty it as soon as possible



Locking block


Release the lock block to open the up housing


Put back the up housing, and fasten the locking block

Warning: When the filters are obviously covered with dust or the suction decreases considerably, please clean it in time, for this can improve the working efficiency and extend the life time of the cleaner.


Never use the machine without filters.


Twist the locking knob with a anti-clockwise force, take off the filters

1.1 INTRODUCTION

i *N.B.*

Before using the appliance, please read this manual and the “Operation and Maintenance” manual supplied with the machine carefully.

This manual and the “Operation and maintenance manual” form an integral part of the machine itself. They must therefore be kept in a safe place where they are accessible to all users (operators and maintenance personnel) throughout the life of the machine until it is scrapped.

1.2 GENERAL WARNINGS

- Plastic bags, polystyrene, paper clips, etc. must not be left within the reach of children, as these are potential sources of danger.
- Ensure that the voltage matches that indicated on the data plate before turning the unit on.
- To unplug the unit from the socket, pull the plug itself and NOT the cable.
- Unwind the entire power cable when using the unit.
- Solely approved extension cables can be used. These must be adequate for the power of the unit and must also be in good condition.
- Do not use the unit if either the plug or power cable is not in good condition.
- If the power cable is damaged, this can only be replaced by a technical support centre that is authorised by the manufacturer.
- Do not slide the power cable on sharp edges.
- Do not pinch or crush the power cable.
- Do not use the unit with wet or damp hands.
- Do not leave the unit exposed to the elements.

- Do not use the unit if its operation is faulty. Take this to an authorised technical support centre.
- Should an anomaly arise, contact an authorised technical support centre and always request original spare parts.
- The plug must be removed from the socket before any maintenance or cleaning procedures are implemented.
- Do not wash the unit with jets of water.
- Do not immerse the unit into water or other liquids.
- Clean the unit with a cloth dampened with water; do not use abrasive detergents, trichloroethene or solvents.
- When depositing the unusable unit at appropriate collection points, the power cord must be removed in order to ensure it is not used.
- The unit is not intended to be used by persons (including children) whose physical, sensorial or mental capacities are reduced, or who lack experience or knowledge, unless they are supervised or given instructions on how to use the unit by a person responsible for their safety.

- Children should be supervised to ensure they do not play with the unit.

1.3 DISPOSING OF THE UNIT

Proceed in accordance with local legislation in order to protect the environment.

When the unit is unusable and cannot be repaired, the components are to be disposed of accordingly and separately.

Electrical equipment cannot be disposed of as urban waste and relative standards pertaining to collection, which have been introduced by specific legislations, must be adhered with (Legislative Decree No. 151 dated 25/7/05 - 2002/96/CE - 2003/108/CE)



Electrical equipment has a symbol bearing a crossed out wheeled bin. The symbol indicates that the apparatus was introduced on the market after 13 August 2005 and must be disposed off separately.

Improper or illegal disposal of such equipment or using it incorrectly, can be hazardous to persons and the environment due to the substances and materials contained. Administrative and criminal penalties will be imposed for non-compliance with standards pertaining to the disposal of electrical waste.

1.4 REFERENCE LEGISLATIONS

The appliance has been manufactured in compliance with the Machinery Directive in force and in accordance with the standards indicated in the “CE” Declaration of Conformity.

1.5 UNPACKING

After removing the package as indicated in the instructions shown on the package itself, check the integrity of the unit and all components supplied.

If any evident damage is noticed, contact the retailer or an authorised technical support centre.


